- The Terrace
- Leisure Club

## BEDROOMS

• We have non-allergic bedding.

## LEVEL ACCESS BEDROOMS

- From the main entrance to the bedroom, there is level access.
- The route to the bedroom is 750mm wide.
- The bedroom door is 750mm wide.
- There is unobstructed floor space 1200mm by 900mm.
- The bathroom has a level access shower.

## HEARING

- Some bedroom TV's have subtitles.
- We have a hearing loop in reception.
- Some staff have disability awareness training.

# VISUAL

- The walls and the doors have high colour contrast.
- Some parts of the venue have low lighting.

# GENERAL

- There is at least one public toilet for disabled visitors (one in Horsley Place and one in Horsley Towers)
- Staff are available 24 hours a day.
- Some staff have disability awareness training.
- We have emergency evacuation procedures for disabled visitors.

# TRAVEL BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

- The nearest train station is Horsley.
   The train station is 1.1miles / 1.8 km from De Vere Horsley Estate
- Horsley station is located on the main line Guildford London Waterloo

#### PARKING

- Our main reception car park has dedicated accessible parking spaces less than 50m from the main entrance.
- The Towers car park has parking available less than 50m from the entrance and these can be reserved on request.
- There is a drop-off point at the main entrance. The drop-off point has a dropped kerb.

# Path to main entrance

• There is a down path from the drop off point to the entrance

## Main entrance

- The main entrance has level access.
- The door is 1500mm wide.
- The main door is automatic

# Getting around inside

## VISUAL IMPAIRMENT - GENERAL INFORMATION

- We have high colour contrast between walls and door frames.
- Some parts of the venue have low lighting.

## LIFT

#### We have two assisted lifts:

- Link from 700s bedrooms to the Corridor to Main Reception
- Tunnel from 700s bedrooms to Court restaurant

## RECEPTION

- There is a down path from the drop off point to the entrance
- The door is 2000mm wide.
- You can sit down at reception.

## BEDROOMS

- All bedrooms have windows.
- Bedrooms have ceiling lights, wall lights, floor standing lights, bedside lamps, desk or table lamps and natural daylight.
- Lights are LED and energy saving. Some TVs have subtitles.
- All bedrooms are non-smoking.
- We have non-allergic bedding.
- All bedrooms have fitted carpets.
- From the main entrance to this area, there is level access.

# ACCESSIBLE ROOMS

- The bedroom is double. The bathroom is ensuite. The bathroom has a separate shower. The shower has a seat. The shower has a handrail.
- The bathroom has a level access shower. The level access shower has a seat. There is a shower chair available. The level access shower has handrails.
- The toilets have handrails. The taps are lever operated.
- Bedrooms in 700s block accessible with assisted lift or through Horsley Court reception

# MAIN BAR - HORSLEY PLACE

- From the main entrance to the bar, there is level access.
- From the bar to the lounge there are three steps

# SWIMMING POOL

Swimming Pool with changing rooms – located at the back
of the lounge area; we provide towels at the main reception,
where the guests and leisure club members need to register.

### GYM

 The Gym – same location as the swimming pool, with same procedure

## PUBLIC TOILET

• From the main entrance to the public toilet, there is level access.

### PLACE TO EAT AND DRINK - THE BRASSERIE

- From the main entrance to the dining area, there is level access.
   To get to a table, there are no steps.
- If you need table service, staff can help you.
- The route through the dining area is 800mm wide, or more.
- There is background music sometimes.
- The table and plates have high colour contrast.
- We cater for sugar free (diabetic), vegetarian, gluten free (coeliacs), lactose free (dairy free), nut free, vegan, kosher and halal specific diets.

## PLACE TO EAT AND DRINK - THE MAIN BAR

- From the main entrance to the dining area, there is level access to high tables
- The lounge area with coffee tables is accessible by the steps (3) or a longer route for guests that are using wheelchair staff to direct and help
- If you need table service, staff can help you.
- The route through the dining area is 800mm wide, or more.
- There is background music sometimes.
- The table and plates have high colour contrast.
- We cater for sugar free (diabetic), vegetarian, gluten free (coeliacs), lactose free (dairy free), nut free, vegan, kosher and halal specific diets.

# MAIN GARDENS

• From the main entrance to the gardens, there are 6 steps.

There is no lift and no ramp. An alternative step free route is available via main reception and driveway.

## TERRACE

- From the main entrance to the bar, there is level access.
- There are steps to the terrace, inside and outside
